4. Qur'an compilation - today's Qur'an is the **same** as compiled.
5. All words translated except **Allah, Rabb**. No use of 'God'. Extra words in parenthesis are for clarification only.
6. All **numerical** values are expressed **like**... 1/6, 1/5, 1/4, 1/3, 1/2, 2/3, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 100, 1,000, 50,000.
7. Chapter # and Ayat # are numbered: Ya-Seen Last ayat: **36:83**

The Makkans joined the Muslims after they saw no revenge or retaliation rather he announced general amnesty to all the enemies and treated the citizens of the city with generosity. 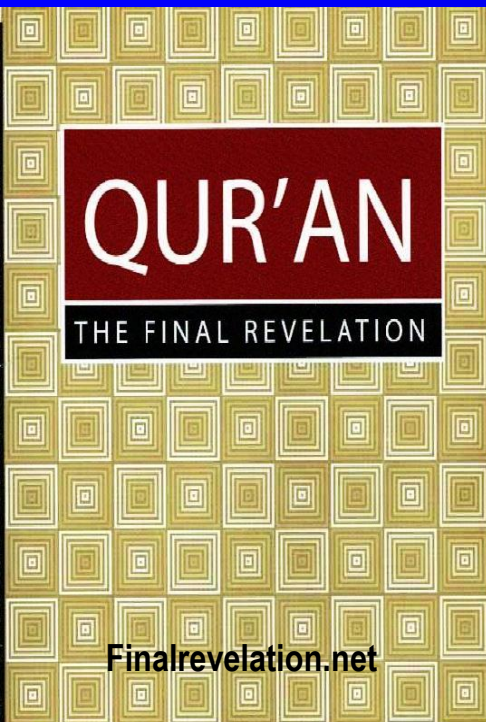

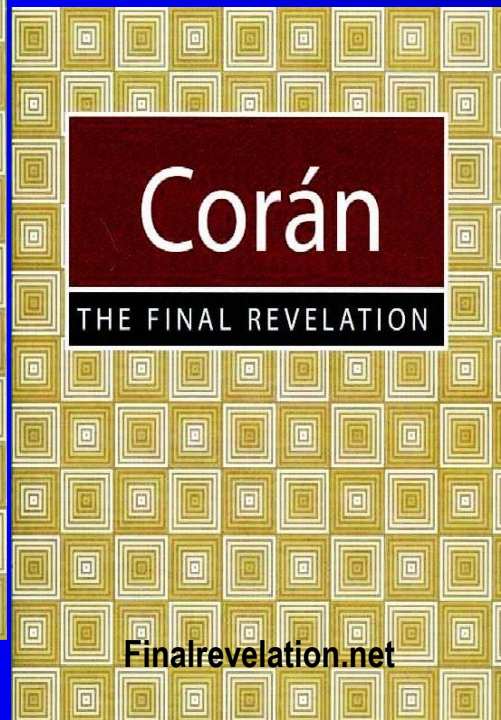

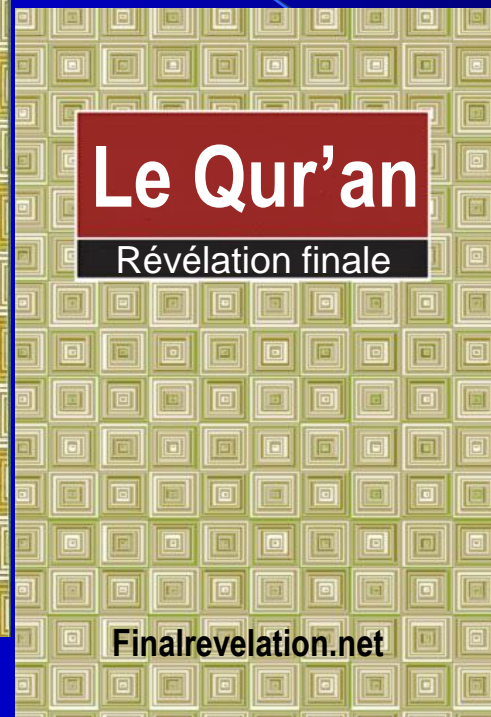
